## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Jagarlamudi Chandramouli College of Law is named after Sri Jagarlamudi Chandramouli, Advocate, former Member of Rajya Sabha, former Member of AP State Legislative Assembly, Educationalist and Philanthropist. The College is sponsored by Nagarjuna Education Society, Guntur (Regd. No. 56 of 1967) and was inaugurated on 22-06- 1991 by Hon'ble Justice (Retd.) S. Parvatha Rao the then Judge of High Court of A.P. and is affiliated to the Acharya Nagarjuna University (ANU), having permission of Andhra Pradesh State Government and approval of affiliation of Bar Council of India (BCI). At present the College offers a 3 Year LLB course with an intake of 180 students, 5 Year BA LLB course with an intake of 120 students and a 5 Year BBA LLB course with an intake of 60 students and LLM course with two specializations.

The programs offered at college incorporate many activities like debate, moot court etc. Jagarlamudi Chandramouli College of Law constantly endeavors to provide the best possible facilities towards attaining its desired objectives of providing quality education and selflessly strives for the betterment of the students.

## ABOUT THE MOOT

The College gives top priority to classroom teaching. Apart from this the College constitutes various cells/committees that are run by the students, like, the Moot Court Committee, Sports and Cultural Committee, JCCL Career guidance cell, Legal Aid Cell, Medical camps by JCCL OSA etc. College has an Alumni Association, which consists of the practicing advocates, judicial officers, judges, professionals, and so on. To enhance teaching learning practices, periodic special lectures and seminars by eminent jurists and legal practitioners are organized by the institution.

After *successfully conducting the 1st National Moot Court Competition in the month of February, 2020, 2nd National Moot Court Competition in the month of February, 2023, 3rd National Moot Court Competition in the month of February, 2024 and 4th Moot Court Competition in the month of February, 2025* the Management this year is very happy to add up one more to the list – **The 5th Moot Court Competition on 7th and 8th (Saturday & Sunday) of February, 2026.**

Moot Court is going to be developed into a key extracurricular activity in Jagarlamudi Chandramouli College of Law, as the College feels that mooting helps the law students the best. The College deems it as a right path to reach out to the future needs of legal aspirants and to recognize their talent and help them improve their skills of drafting and mooting. Therefore, here stands the J.C.College of Law conducting, its Fifth Moot Court Competition.

## Moot Case

Police have charged Vikhyath with the offence under Section 69, *Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita*, (*BNS*), 2023. The Charge Sheet states as follows:

Vikhyath and Adhvithi joined, in the year 2015-16, Five Year B.A., LL.B. Course in J C College of Law, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh. Both are from affluent families. In the first year of study itself the two became close friends. Within a short time, they have agreed to marry in future, after settling in life. Thereafter, they lived almost like husband and wife. Both families knew about the relationship. After completing Law Course the two settled in Law practice. In pursuance of their agreement to marry in future they both jointly purchased a house to live in.

In the beginning of the year 2025 Adhvithi found a lot of change in the attitude of Vikhyath and Adhvithi felt that Vikhyath has been indifferent and avoiding her. When Adhvithi grilled Vikhyath, he told that he would not be marrying her. When Adhvithi questioned the reason for the same, Vikhyath did not state any thing specific. On enquiry with friends Adhvithi came to know that Vikhyath has been becoming more religious and wants to be a celibate. Adhvithi took up the matter with the parents of Vikhyath, but in vain. Ultimately, she filed FIR against Vikhyath with Guntur Police under Section 69 *BNS*.

During the trial, the Sessions Judge getting satisfied that in terms of provisions of Sections 63 and 28 of *BNS* Section 69 *BNS* is redundant, has referred the matter under Section 436 *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)*, 2023 to High Court. In conformity with the Order of the High Court, the Court of Sessions has disposed of the matter under Section 437 *BNSS* by acquitting the accused.

Aggrieved by the decision of Court of Sessions, Adhvithi preferred Appeal to High Court against acquittal. 'Women Power' a voluntary Organization that strives for the rights of women filed an Implead Petition and prayed for upholding of the Constitutional validity of Section 69 *BNS*.

In view of the importance of the matter, Vikhyath has applied for transfer of the matter to Supreme Court. The Supreme Court while getting the case transferred has constituted a Three Judge Bench of the Court to hear the matter. Adhvithi contested the transfer of her Appeal to the Supreme Court.

The Hon'ble Court has framed six questions for adjudication. The matter is posted for arguments.

*Disclaimer: The names of the Hon'ble Courts are used merely for the sake of avoiding coining of fictitious names and for the convenience of the participants.*

## **RULES GOVERNING THE COMPETITION**

### **General**

1. The Competition shall be held for two days on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 (Saturday and Sunday).
2. The Competition shall be open to *bona fide* students pursuing 3 Year LL.B. Course or integrated 5 Year LL.B. Course offered by a Law School/Affiliated Law College/University Department or College/Centre of Legal Education recognized by Bar Council of India.
3. The language of the Competition shall be English.
4. Only 36 teams shall be registered for the Competition on 'first come first serve' basis. The Organizing College shall reserve the right of registration. It may invite to the competition a School/College/Department/Centre that is not registered.
5. Each participating team shall consist of three members i.e. Two Speakers and One Researcher. Due to an exigency the Organizing College may allow a two-member team to participate in the Competition, when registered with three members.
6. One team only is permitted to participate from a School/College/Department/Centre.
7. The participating teams shall bear the travelling and all other incidental expenses.
8. The Organizing College shall provide free lodge and boarding to the participating teams. Depending upon the travel plan of the participating team accommodation shall be provided from afternoon of 6<sup>th</sup> February to afternoon of 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2026. No accommodation shall be provided to the teams from nearby places. Accommodation is provided to participating team members only. Members are expected to use the accommodation in a decent and reasonable manner.
9. The dress to the participants shall be the dress prescribed to Advocates under Advocates Act.
10. **The team of the Organizing College shall participate in the Competition.**
11. The members of the participating teams shall maintain, during the Competition, decency and decorum of the Court and conduct themselves in the manner befitting of the legal profession.
12. No member of any team shall be permitted to hear the arguments in any court hall whilst they are still in the Competition.
13. Any member of the team or any team found in the violation of any of the Rules of the Competition shall be disqualified forthwith.

14. The Organizing College shall have an inherent power to make Rules on any situation not covered in the Rules.
15. The decision of the Principal of the Organizing College shall be final with regard to the interpretation of the Rules and on any other matter or matters relating to the Competition not specifically provided for in the Rules.



22. Best Speaker shall be evaluated on the basis of performance in preliminary rounds.  
The Winner of the Research Test shall be awarded 1) Jagarlamudi Chandramouli College of Law Alumni Trophy, Cash Prize of Rs. 10,000 and Certificate of Appreciation of Merit and 2) J C College of Law Teaching Staff Cash Prize of Rs.5,000 and Certificate of Appreciation of Merit.

All the members of the teams that entered into Quarter final and Semi-final shall be awarded Certificate of Appreciation of Merit. All the members of the other participating teams shall be awarded Certificate of Participation.

## Memorials

28. Each team shall submit Memorials for both Appellant and Respondents.
29. The **text** of the Memorial shall not exceed 25 pages. The Memorials shall be typed on A4 size paper with standard margins on both sides in Times New Roman with font size 12 with double line spacing.
30. Each team shall submit 06 copies of Memorials for each side. The name of the institution or the names of the student participants shall not appear at any place in the Memorial. The Team Code allotted shall be typed at the top right corner of the cover page of the Memorial. **The last date for submission of hard copies is 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026 to the postal address given.**
31. The cover page of the Memorial for the Appellant shall be in blue colour and for the Respondents in red colour. Prefer chart paper or white paper to plastic sheet for cover page. Also prefer staples or cotton thread stitches to spiral binding.

## Conduction of the Competition

33. The competition shall be conducted in four rounds – Preliminary, Quarter, Semi and Final rounds.
34. In the Preliminary rounds each team shall argue for both sides. Eight teams that achieve the highest marks in the Preliminary rounds shall become eligible to enter into the Quarter finals. In case of a tie marks awarded to Memorials shall be considered. If the tie persists toss may be used.
35. Quarter, Semi and Final rounds shall be held on a Knock-Out basis.
36. In the preliminary rounds each team shall get 30 minutes time. The two Speakers can adjust the time between them. But, no Speaker shall argue for more than 20 minutes. In preliminary rounds each team shall get 3 minutes for rebuttals. In Quarter and Semi Final rounds also each team shall get 30minutes time. In all these rounds each team shall get 5 minutes time for rebuttals. In the Final round each team shall get 40 minutes time and 10 minutes for rebuttals.

37. Memorials are valued separately. Memorials for each side shall carry 100 marks. Each Memorial is valued for 50 marks.
